Mount Dinpernalason is east of the Himalayan mountains. It's 6,135 metres high, so it isn't the highest mountain, (Mount Everest is 8,848 metres), but nobody has ever climbed it.

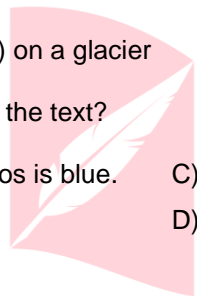
