Parents vs Children					
Ever feel like your parents do not understand you at all? I know it sounds terribly stereotypical, but you cannot					
deny feeling misunderstood. This is common and it is not just our teen-angst. Parents just do not understand					
us; it is as simple as that.					
This is mainly due to the rather large generation gap between us and our parents. Times have changed, and					
for some reason they have a hard time understanding this at times. Back when they were growing up, things					
that we find socially acceptable were considered horribly inappropriate. For example, guys and girls just hanging $\frac{1}{2}$					
out is a lot more common than in the 60's and 70's. Back then a guy politely asked a girl if she would like to
